- The final closing date is **Saturday 12 June**
- Entry forms received at our office after **5pm on Friday 30 April** will automatically incur a surcharge of £25.00. Modern, Classic & Post Classic Newcomers will be exempt from this surcharge
- An email will be sent to you to confirm your entry has been received by this office. You will be notified as soon as possible if your entry has been accepted or held in abeyance. Details of the Steam Packet discount for competitors will be sent with confirmation of acceptance.
- All entries are subject to the issuing of a TT Mountain Course Licence by the ACU. The TT Mountain Course Licence application form must be completed and returned **to the ACU** at the address shown on the form by 14 July. The issue of such a licence by the ACU does not guarantee your acceptance into the event.

One of the most important initiatives is a to recruit new competitors to the MGP and recently we have enjoyed 2 successful visits by some of our enthusiastic MGP Ambassadors and potential Newcomers, supported by the Mike Hailwood Foundation.
